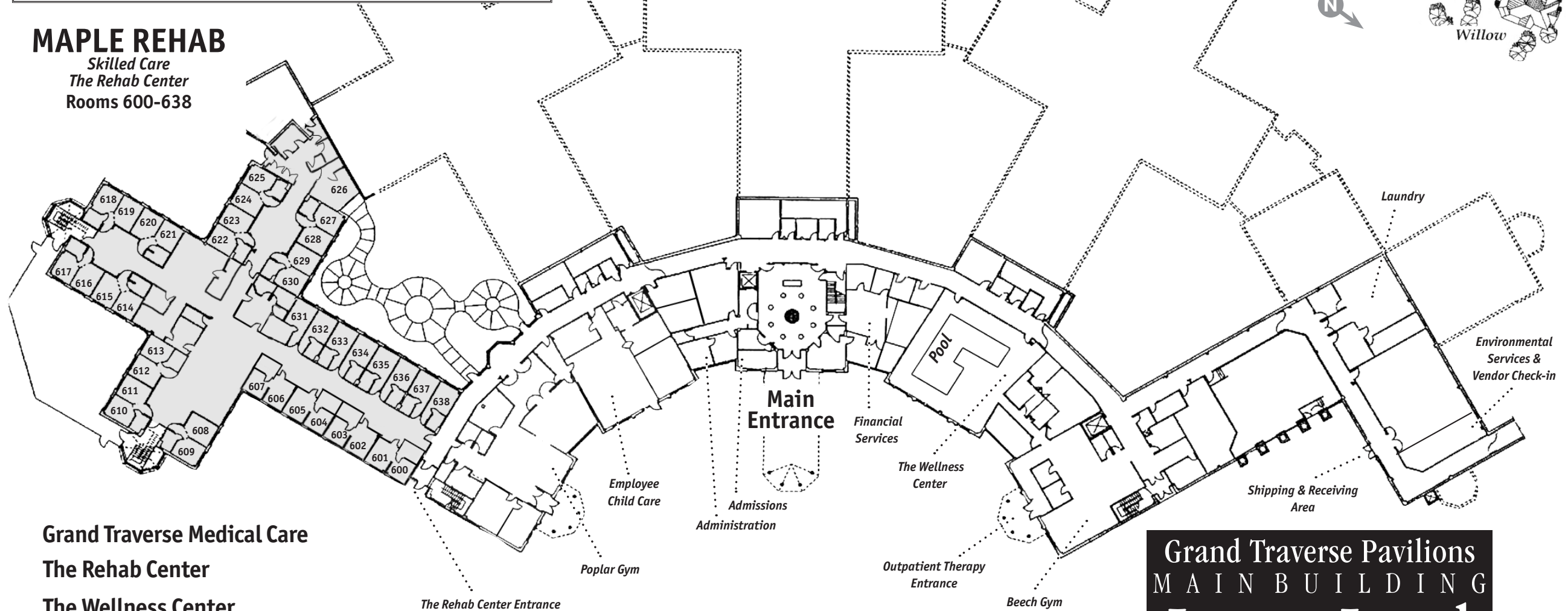


GRAND TRAVERSE PAVILIONS FACTS

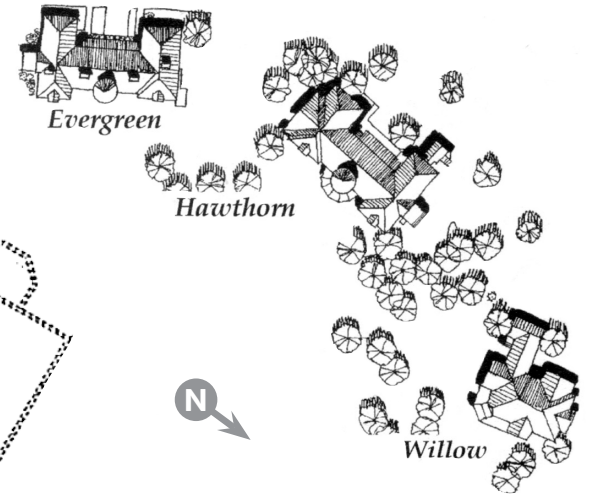
