**New and Improved Air System Added at Grand Traverse Pavilions**

**TRAVERSE CITY, MI** – Enhanced air purification and pathogen reduction are the result of a new nationally recognized and patented induct technology installed recently at Grand Traverse Pavilions.

“This system has been adopted by the Pavilions to provide the utmost in health, comfort, safety and protection of our residents, families and staff.” noted CEO Rose Coleman.

She explained that the system is now used nationwide in public places like schools, hospitals and other healthcare facilities. It works by converting ambient air to inactivate viruses, bacteria and fungi. Additionally, room surface pathogens are also inactivated.

She noted that implementation of the advanced air technology addresses the highest priority of Grand Traverse County residents, i.e. “supporting critical infrastructure needs.”

“By adopting a 24/7 air and surface technology that will impact hundreds of county families and elderly residents served by Grand Traverse Pavilions we are responding to that concern.”

Funding for the new system was through grant awards from the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services Nursing Facility Infection Control and the American Rescue Plan Act.
